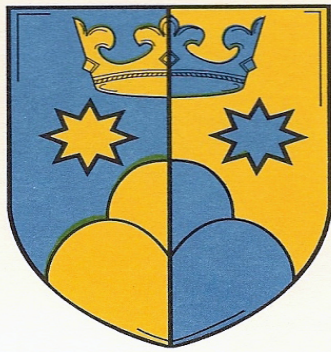

## SACRAMENTS

### Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated the first and third Sunday of each month at 12:45 p.m. Parents are asked to call the Parish Office to schedule a date. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, their marriage must be recognized by the Catholic Church. These requirements are the universal law of the Church, and are not determined by the individual Parish. If the person you choose as godparent fulfills these requirements, they are asked to furnish a statement from their Parish that they are indeed eligible to be a Sponsor.

### Sacrament of Reconciliation

Confessions are heard every Saturday from 4:15 to 4:45 p.m. in the Church.

### Sacrament of Marriage

Diocesan policy requires that couples participate in a marriage preparation program prior to their wedding. To ensure that all the necessary arrangements can be made, couples should contact the Parish Office at least one year in advance of their wedding date, and before any other plans have been made.

### Sacrament of Holy Orders and Consecrated Life

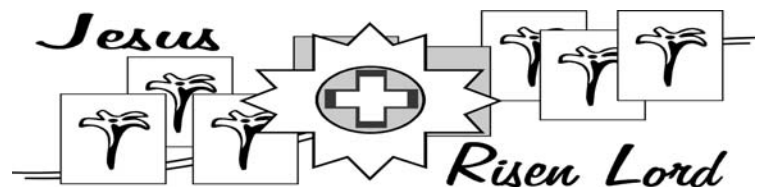

### RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)

A small group process by which a person inquires into becoming a Catholic, and may receive the Sacraments of Initiation, namely Baptism, First Eucharist, and Confirmation, followed by continuous growth in the faith. Anyone interested may contact the Parish Office.

### Ministry to the Sick

Every Sunday morning Ministers of Holy Communion bring the Eucharist to homebound parishioners. To request your name to be placed on the Communion list, please call the Parish Office. The clergy of the parish are available to visit sick family members, whether at home or in the hospital. Please let us know how we can be of assistance to you and your loved ones.

### First Reading: Acts 10:34a, 37-43

In this passage, Peter testifies that he and his followers saw the miracles performed by Christ, witnessed His death, and believe in His resurrection. Now they will proclaim to all that Christ is the Son of God.



### Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4

Paul tells the Colossians that they will appear with Christ in glory. They should be mindful of things above rather than things on earth.

### Gospel: John 20:1-9

In vivid detail, John tells us that when Mary Magdalene visited Christ's tomb, the tomb was empty. She told the apostles, who ran to the tomb, and saw the "wrappings" on the ground. The disciple who entered first "saw and believed."

## PASTORAL COUNCIL OF OUR LADY OF THE MOUNT

The Parish Pastoral Council of Our Lady of the Mount Church is in the process of identifying and contacting potential candidates for several seats on the Council starting with the 2011-2012 term.

These basic criteria are considered necessary for a parishioner to be given consideration. The parishioner should:

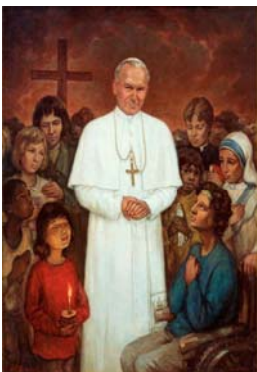
- Be a baptized, practicing Catholic;
- Have been a registered member of the parish for at least five years;
- Be a participant in the ongoing life of the parish, especially Sunday Eucharist;
- Be at least twenty-one years of age.

In addition, he or she should possess the following characteristics:

- A desire for spiritual growth in oneself and in the parish;
- Enthusiasm about the future directions of the parish;
- Willingness to listen, to speak honestly, and to work toward consensus;
- The ability to inspire and empower others, and to delegate;
- Flexibility and openness with people and ideas.

Length of Service: It is recommended that the length of service for council members be no less than three years.
